The *Agrobacterium* strains were grown in the medium containing 100 mg/l of tetracycline. The cell concentration of the *Agrobacterium* strains was adjusted to 10<sup>8</sup> cells/ml. The cell suspension was mixed with the plant tissue and the transformation efficiency was determined. The results are the mean of three independent experiments. Error bars represent standard deviation.
