Existing Roads 1.

Attachment I shows the route to the location from Roswell. The US, State, and County roads shown need no improvement. The existing Frivate Road may need light blading and will be caleched if required. Access road (300') will need to be built. Any necessary construction materials will be obtained from commercial sources.

The location is approximately 25 miles south-east of Roswell. From Roswell go east approximately 16 miles on U.S. 380. Turn south on County Road 53 and proceed approximately 7 miles to what is called "Wade Ranch" on AttachmentI and II. Continue 1-1/2 miles south-west. Turn North and proceed 1/4 mile to point where access road begins. Turn West on access road, a distance of 300'. and the second second

2. Planned Access Road

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A. The proposed access road will be approximately 300' in length from the point of origin to the drill pad.

As shown on Exhibit I, Section 4 and 5 of T 12 S - R 27 E contain the only portion of road falling on Federal Surface. An application for Right-of-Way has been applied for through the B.L.M. on the road in Section 4. This portion of the road measures 6600 feet in length. USA-NM-14301 (drillsite lease) contains the S/2N/2, S/2 of Section 5. The road on this section totals 2640 feet in length of which 300 feet is new road.

- B. Proposed access roads will be 12 feet in width (driving surface) except at point of origin, adjacent to the existing road, at which point enough additional width will be provided to allow trucks and equipment to turn.
- C. The new road will be covered with the required depth of caliche. The surface will be crowned with drainage on both sides if required.
- D. The access route will be flagged and the road clearly visible.
