

This plan is submitted with the Application for Permit to Drill the above described well. The purpose of the plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of necessary surface distrubance involved, and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitiating the surface after completion of the operation so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation.

1. EXISTING ROADS

- A. Exhibit "C" is a section of a map showing the location of proposed well as staked. From Roswell go east on US 380 approximately 19 miles. Go north through a cattle guard. Follow the main road north approximately 11.5 miles to the El Paso Natural Gas Pipeline. Go over ramp to north side of pipeline and turn to the east. Follow the road through 2 cattle guards approximately 5 miles. Turn left and travel approximately 250 feet to location.
- B. Exhibit "D" is a plat showing existing roads and stock tanks within 1/2 mile of proposed location.
- C. Minor repairs will be made on the existing roads as well as caliche in some spots.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD

- A. <u>Length and Width</u>: We will build approximately 250' of road south off of the El Paso Natural Gas Pipeline road.
- B. <u>Surfacing Material</u>: Caliche will be obtained and hauled from the caliche pit shown on Exhibit "C".
- C. Maximum Grade: 1 percent
- D. Turnouts: None required
