We propose to drill through the Abo formation to a depth of 3800'. We will drill 12 1/4" hole to 900' and set 8 5/8" casing with cement circulated to shut off all fresh water zones. After testing, we will drill out with 7 7/8" bit to TD. We will run a DLL-MSFL and a CNL-FDC log. If commercial, 4 1/2" production casing will be run and cemented with an adequate cover, perforated and stimulated as needed for production.

Blowout Prevention Program: An 8" 3000psig W.P. double gate hydraulic Shaffer BOP (or equivalent) with drill pipe rams and blind rams will be installed on the 8 5/8" casing. All fill, kill and choke lines will be a minimum of 2" 2000psi working pressure. The rams will be closed daily and checked for proper operation. (schematic drawing enclosed)

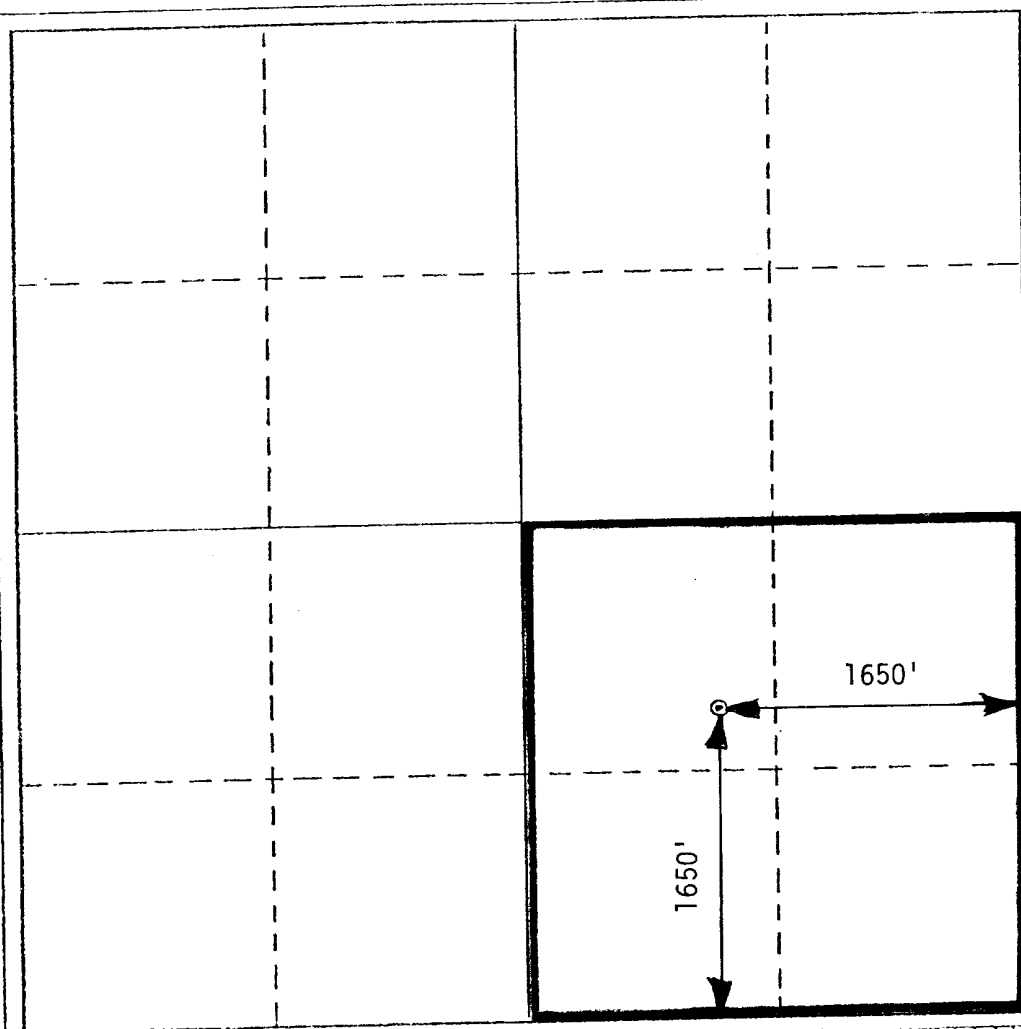

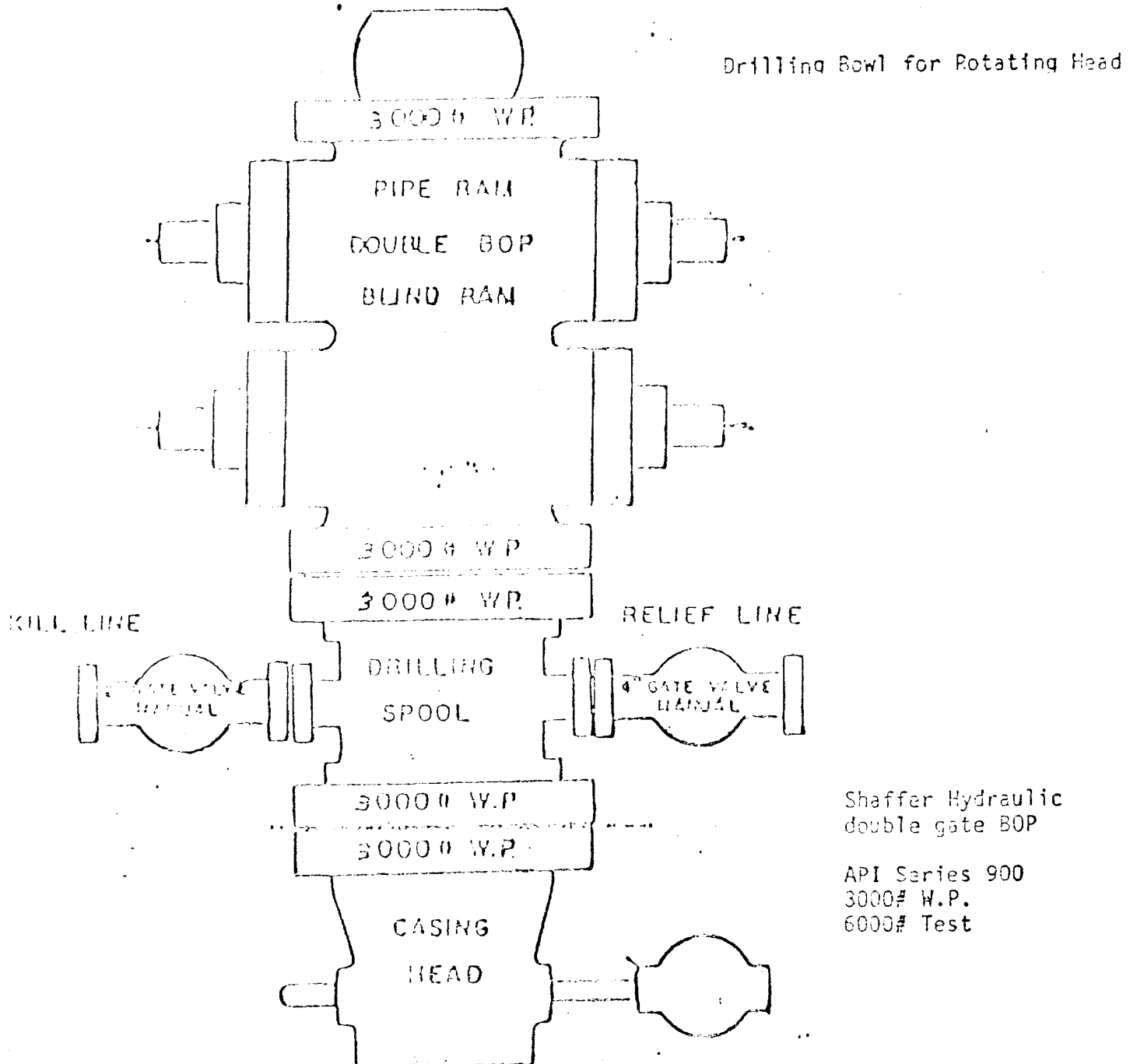
