SUBJECT: Request to surface commingle gas production from Getty GC Fed. Com. Wells No. (1) and 2 (Lease No. NM-54388), Sec. 7, T6S, R26E, Chaves County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

Getty Oil Company, as operator of the Getty GC Fed. Com. Lease, respectfully requests approval to surface commingle gas production from Wells No. 1 and 2. These wells are dry gas wells producing from the Pecos Slope Abo Pool. The Lease is located in the north half of Section 7, T6S, R26E. Getty Oil Company, which donated the north half of the north half of the section, is a 49.97% working interest owner. Cavalcade Oil Corporation, which donated the south half of the north half of the section, is a 50.03% working interest owner.

The gas transporter for the Lease is Transwestern Pipeline Company. As per the Gas Purchase Agreement, Transwestern has installed only one line and sales meter to the Lease, located at Well No. 2. Getty requests approval to tie Well No. 1 into this sales meter, thus commingling the gas production from the two wells prior to being metered, as shown on the attached figure. Gas production from the two wells will be allocated by a test meter. As shown on the attached figure, each well may be tested individually. Gas production will be allocated by testing each well once a month, multiplying by the number of days produced, and multiplying by an allocation correction ratio in order to match the actual gas sales through Transwestern's meter.

This plan will not affect revenues or royalty payments, as each well is governed by the same gas contract.

This request is also being sent to New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Santa Fe for their consideration and approval.
