Upon review of the above-described application, it has been determined that the well does not qualify for administrative approval of downhole commingling due to the pressure of the formations. Rule 303.C.(1)(b)(ii) states that: "the bottomhole pressure of the highest pressured commingled zone does not exceed the original reservoir pressure of any other commingled zone in the wellbore, adjusted to a common datum." Your application states that the current pressure of the Penn zone is 2,349 psi, and that the original reservoir pressure of the Abo zone is 1300 psi.

The application may be considered for approval at a Division Examiner hearing. Please let me know whether you wish to set the application for hearing.
