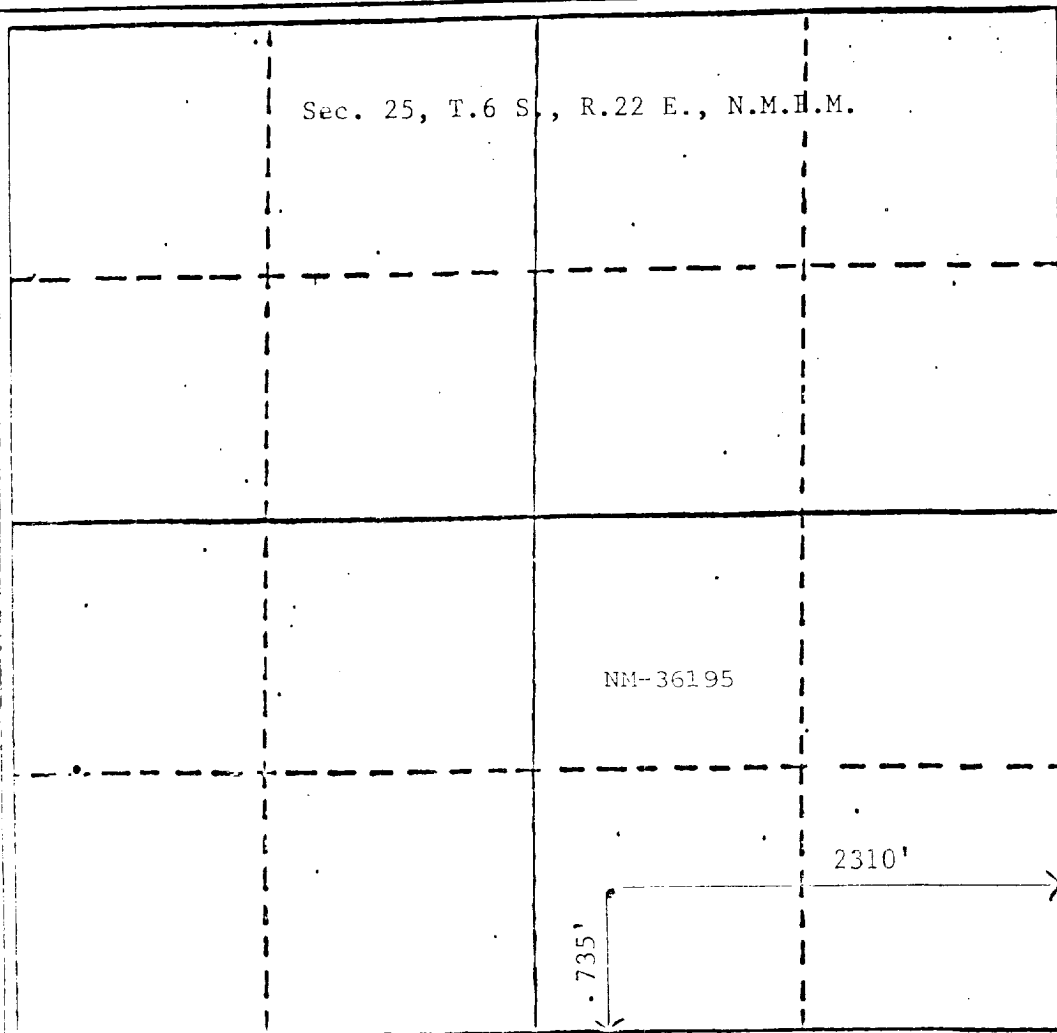
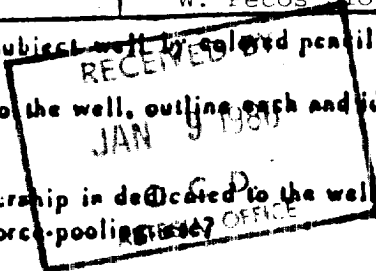

AMENDMENT

TO

MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN

MCKAY OIL CORPORATION
Remmele Federal #2

This plan is submitted as an admendment to the application for permit to Drill the above described well. The purpose of the plan is to describe the change in location of the well.

1. EXISTING ROADS:

- A. Exhibit "A" is a portion of a road map showing the location of the proposed well as staked. The well is approximately 21 miles North of Roswell, N.M.
- B. Directions: Heading North out of Roswell, New Mexico for approximately 18 miles and turn left on county road #39. Go past the ranch house and the Arroyo del Macho which are 3 1/2 down the county road. Continue west on that road staying right at each fork in the road for approximately 2 miles. Just before you get to the China Draw State oil well turn left and proceed around that location until you reach the El Pas Natural Gas pipeline. The new access road will go to the left up the hill to a fence. Turn right and go approximately 1 mile and turn to the right and go approximately 1/4 mile to the location.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD:

- A. Length and Width: The new access road will be about 1 1/2 mile long and 12' wide (20' ROW)
- B. Surfacing Materials: Approximately 4" inches of caliche will be used where needed.
- C. Turnouts: One approximately every 1/4 mile.

- D. Maximum Grade: About 3%
- E. Drainage Design: The road will be bladed to a 6" crown and 4' shoulders.
- F. Culverts: None necessary
- G. Cuts and Fills: None necessary
- H. Gates, Cattleguards: one cattleguard will be installed on the new access road where the road crosses the Section line for Section 36 into Section 25.

4. LOCATION OF EXISTING AND/OR PROPOSED FACILITIES:

- A. same as original plan.

5. LOCATION AND TYPE OF WATER SUPPLY:

- A. same as original plan.

6. SOURCE OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS:

- A. same as original plan.

7. METHODS OF HANDLING WASTE DISPOSAL:

- A. same as original plan.

8. AUXILIARY FACILITIES:

- A. None necessary

9. WELL SITE LAYOUT:

- a. same as original plan.
- B. The location has a slope to the south.

10. PLANS FOR RESTORATION OF THE SURFACE:

- A. Any soil or vegetation disturbed will be noted and returned to location. This soil will be used to re-build the location and road when drilling and production activities have ended.

11. OTHER INFORMATION:

- A. Topography: The topography is flat in the vicinity of the access road and drill pad. Regional slope is east toward the Arroyo del Macho which is approximately 1 1/2 miles from the location.
- B. Soil: Sandy loam with limestone outcropping.
- C. Flora and Fauna: The flora consists of typical desert vegetation, such as yucca, cactus and various grasses. Fauna consists of desert wildlife such as coyotes, rodents, snakes, deer and antelope.
- D. Ponds or Streams: Arroyo del Macho is about 1 1/2 miles east of the proposed location.
- E. Residences and other Structures: None are in the immediate area.
- F. Archaeological, Historical and Other Cultural Sites: No artifacts are noted in the area of the pad or access road. An Archaeologist from Eastern New Mexico University has checked the location and access road and furnishes a favorable recommendation.
- G. Land Use: Grazing
- H. Surface Ownership: Federal

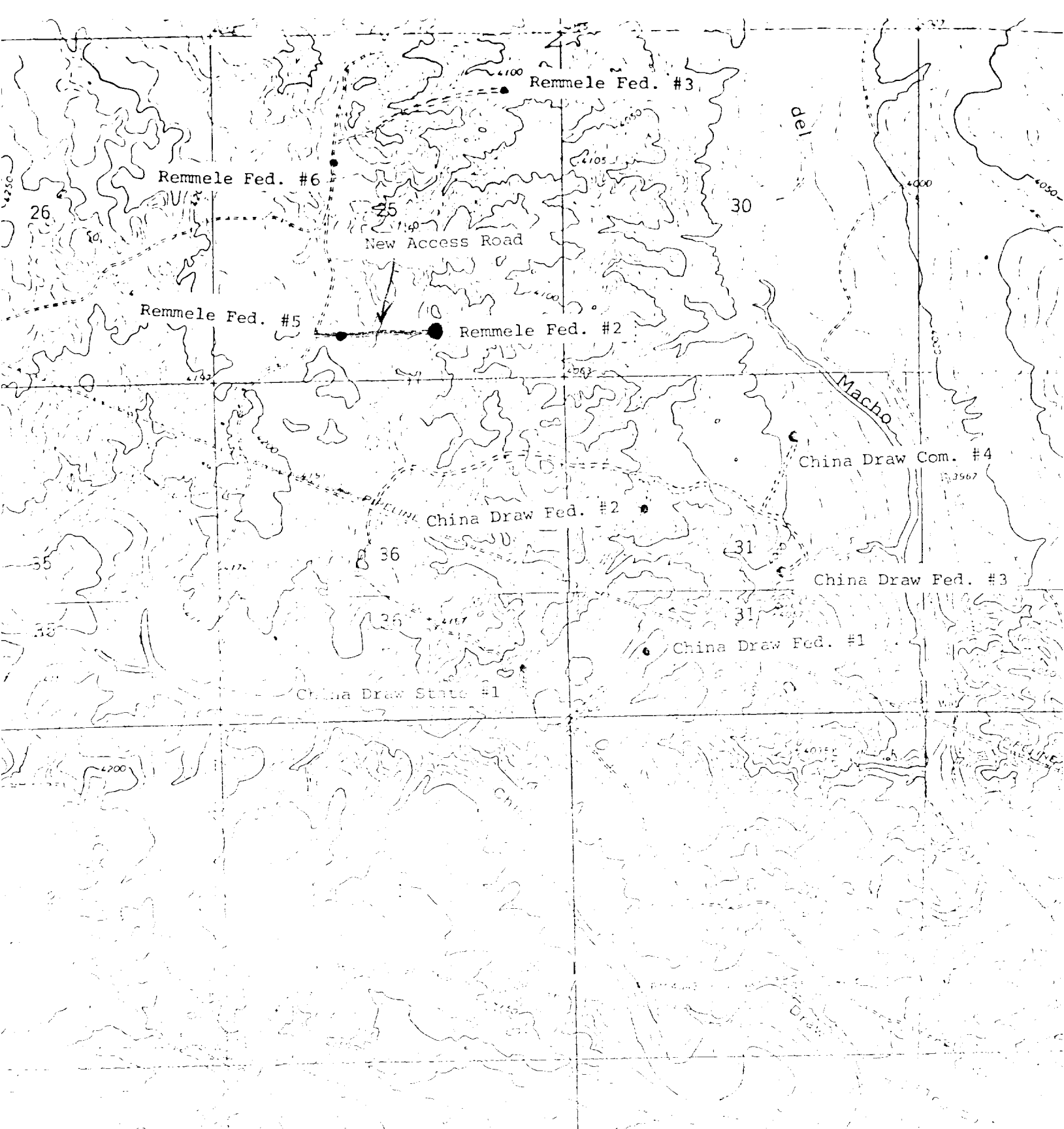
