8. In those areas where erosion control structures are required to stabilize soil conditions, the grantee will install such structures as are suitable for the specific soil conditions being encountered and which are in accordance with sound resource management practices.

done according to the attached seeding requirements, using the following seed mix.



10. All above-ground structures not subject to safety requirements shall be painted by the holder to blend with the natural color of the landscape. The paint used shall be a color which simulates "Standard Environmental Colors" -Carlsbad Canyon, Munsell Soil Color No. 2.5Y 6/2 (formerly Sandstone Brown); designated by the Rocky Mountain Five State Interagency Committee.

11. The pipeline will be identified by signs at the point of origin and completion of the right-of-way and at all road crossings. At a minimum, signs will state the holder's name, BLM serial number, and the product being transported. All signs and information thereon will be posted in a permanent, conspicuous manner, and will be maintained in a legible condition for the life of the pipeline.

12. The holder shall not use the pipeline route as a road for purposes other than routine maintenance as determined necessary by the Authorized Officer in consultation with the holder. The holder will take whatever steps are necessary to ensure that the pipeline route is not used as a roadway.

13. Special Stipulations:

The segment of pipeline crossing the rocky ledge does not have to be buried. This surface segment will be painted as specified under stipulation no.10.
