ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on August 6, 1986, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 21st day of August, 1986, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Cibola Energy Corporation, seeks approval of an unorthodox oil well location for its proposed Hadley Well No. 1 to be drilled 2290 feet from the North line and 1200 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 36, Township 10 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, to test the Devonian formation, Chaves County, New Mexico.

(3) The SE/4 NE/4 of said Section 36 is to be dedicated to the well.

(4) A well at said unorthodox location will better enable applicant to produce the oil underlying the proration unit.

(5) No offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox location.

(6) Approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable
