1. Loaded hole with 8.8 #/gal drilling mud.
2. Displaced 25 sack cement plug across top of Bliss from TD 5129 to 4890.
3. Displaced 25 sack cement plug across top of Ellenburger from 4180 to 4310.
4. Displaced 25 sack cement plug across top of Montoya from 3825 to 3955.
5. Displaced 25 sack cement plug across top of Fusselman, 1/2 in and 1/2 out of 7" liner seat from 3485 to 3615.
6. No dry hole marker set or no additional cement plugs set inside 7" liner or 9 5/8" casing due to releasing remainder of well to the Bureau of Land Management of the U.S. Department of the Interior to complete as a fresh water supply well.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

RELEASE OF WELL

WHEREAS, that certain Oil and Gas Lease was made and entered into on July 1, 1970, by and between the United States of America, Lessor, (Date) and Cities Service Oil Company, Lessee, Serial Number NM 11871; and

WHEREAS, Cities Service Oil Company, whose address is P.O. Box 69 Hobbs, New Mexico 88240 is the present Lessee of record;

WHEREAS, said Lease provides that there is reserved by the Lessor all rights pursuant to Section 40 of the Mineral Leasing Act of February 25, 1920, (41 Stat. 437), as amended) to acquire the well for a water well located on said Lease.

WHEREAS, Cities Service Oil Company, as operator has drilled and completed a certain well located 1980' feet and 1980' feet from the North and West Lines Sec. 6 T. 22S, R. 2W, N.M.P.M., a portion of the above lease, which well appears to contain water of such quality and quantity to be valuable and usable at a reasonable cost for agriculture, domestic or other purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Cities Service Oil Company as Lessee and the Cities Service Oil Company as operator will release, relinquish and quitclaim all right, title, and interest in and to said well to the United States of America in lieu of plugging same to surface; and

WHEREAS, the United States of America, acting by and through the Secretary of the Interior desires, pursuant to said Lease and said Mineral Leasing Act of February 20, 1920, as amended to take over said well with the express understanding and agreement that the taking over of such well will not restrict operations of said lease.
