With reference to the above mentioned well, and in view of the fact that we have not had any reports from you of your operations other than our weekly scout report, which indicates you were fishing for drill pipe from Nov. 10, 1953 to Dec. 9, 1953 and I believe the rotary rig was moving back to Hagerman, New Mexico on Dec. 16, 1953.

At this point I would like to point out Rule 202, Paragraph C of the Rules & Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission as follows: "When drilling operations have been suspended for 60 days the well shall be plugged and abandonment shall be obtained from the Commission."

We have Form C-102 Notice of Temporary Abandonment for your Duncan & Branin Franks #1 well and unless you intend to resume operations in the very near future, I suggest that you obtain permit for temporary abandonment on this well by submitting Form C-102 to this office.
