August 5, 1952 Spudded hole.  
August 11, 1952 Ran 357' 4" 13" OD Casing to hold back savings, water in hole.  
Sept. 9, 1952 Ran 1291' 8" 10 3/4" casing, 85 sks. cement, ran into more water just under pipe.  
Sept. 9, 1952 Pulled 357' 4" 13" OD casing.  
October 4, 1952 Ran 1184' 8 5/8" casing, water shut off by mudding pipe. Drilled to 1660' and hit another water state in the formation. Making more water than we can bail.  
October 27, 1952 Tearing down and moving cable tool rig off of location, moving on C & L Drilling Co. Wilson Giant Rotary rig to continue drilling.
