DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

- \* Mr. J. Perkins, Lion Oil Company Representative, was granted verbal approval on May 26, 1952 to plug the above listed well by Mr. Hanson, Representative of New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, Artesia, New Mexico.

The plugging method outlined by Mr. Hanson was carried out as follows: Well bore from total depth 593' to 400' was filled with rock & heavy mud. Halliburton placed cement plug from 400' to 370' with 40 sacks cement. Well bore from 370 to near surface was filled with heavy mud-laden fluid. Placed cement plug in well bore at surface with 10 sacks. A 4' marker was placed in surface plug.
