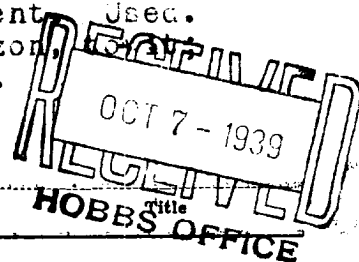

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Started drilling on September 12. September 13th set 110 feet of 10 inch 40 lbs. new casing. cemented with 20 sacks. Small amount of water at 60 feet. Drilled to September 26th, set 850 feet of 7 inch o.d. used casing 24 lbs. Set with heavy mud. No cement used. No Artesian water was found at the Artesian water horizon, 700 to 745 feet. Shut down September 26th, Temporarily.
