DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Filled with heavy mud from 1281 feet to 1245 feet then made a bridge and cemented, using 10 sacks at 1240 feet then pulled 7 inch casing, got shoe joint. Filled with heavy mud to 1040 feet and cemented with 10 sacks then filled hole with heavy mud to 864 feet, cemented in bottom of 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ inch casing with 10 sacks of cement. Cut casing at 720 feet again at 620 feet but casing will not pull. Have temporary ceased work and will resume work about October 6th.
