5 1/2	16lb	new	2200feet	cemented

The above casing program is based on the possibility of finding excess water at the above depths--if no water is encountered in that particular zone, no casing will be run. The State Engineer's office has approved the program and authorized the running in of all pipe if no usable water is encountered.

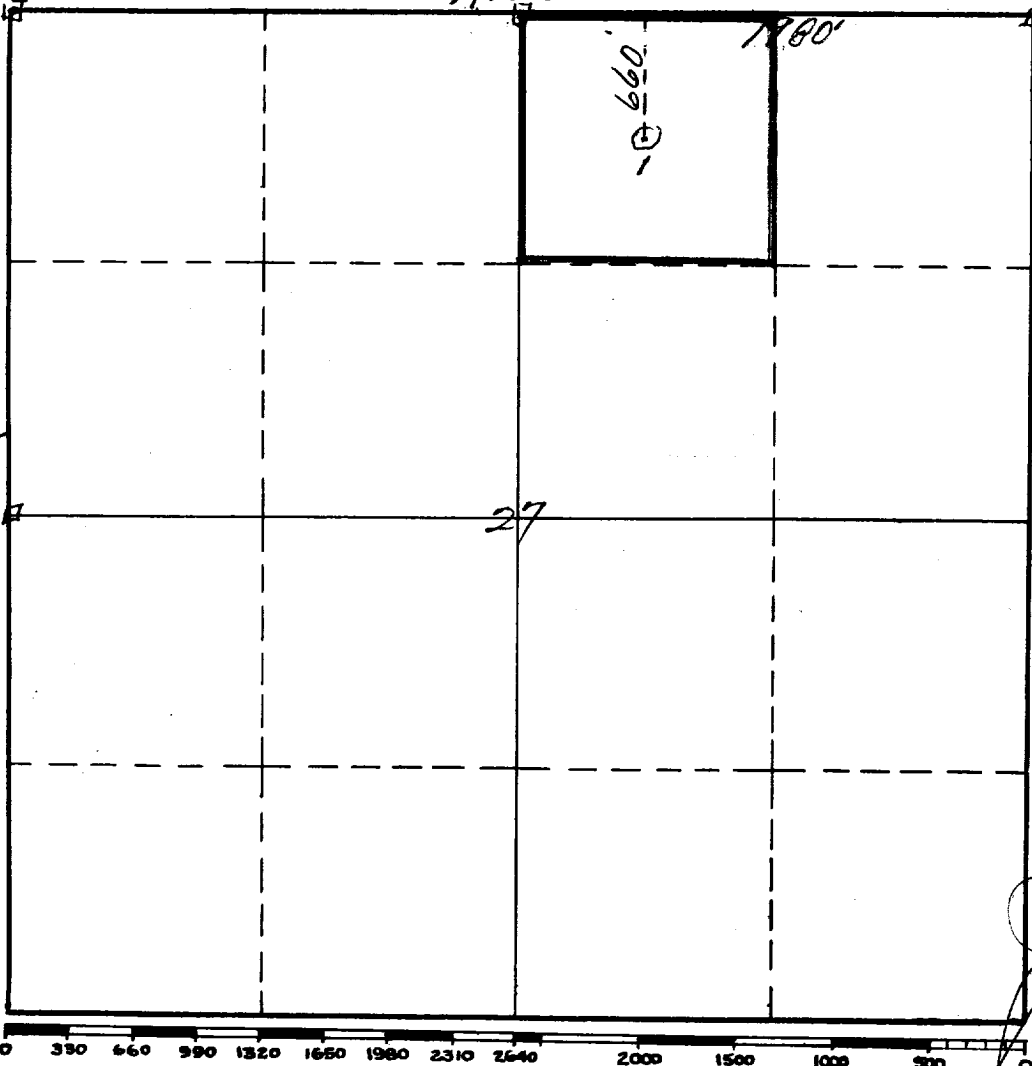
