DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill this well with cable tools to an approximate depth of 2,300 feet to test the San Andres formation. We propose to set approximately 450 feet of 10 3/4" casing, mudding same, approximately 1200 feet of 8 5/8" casing and approximately 2,300 feet of 5 1/2" oil string if production is encountered, cementing with 100 sacks. We will cement the 8 5/8" casing if we make a well and cementing is required.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

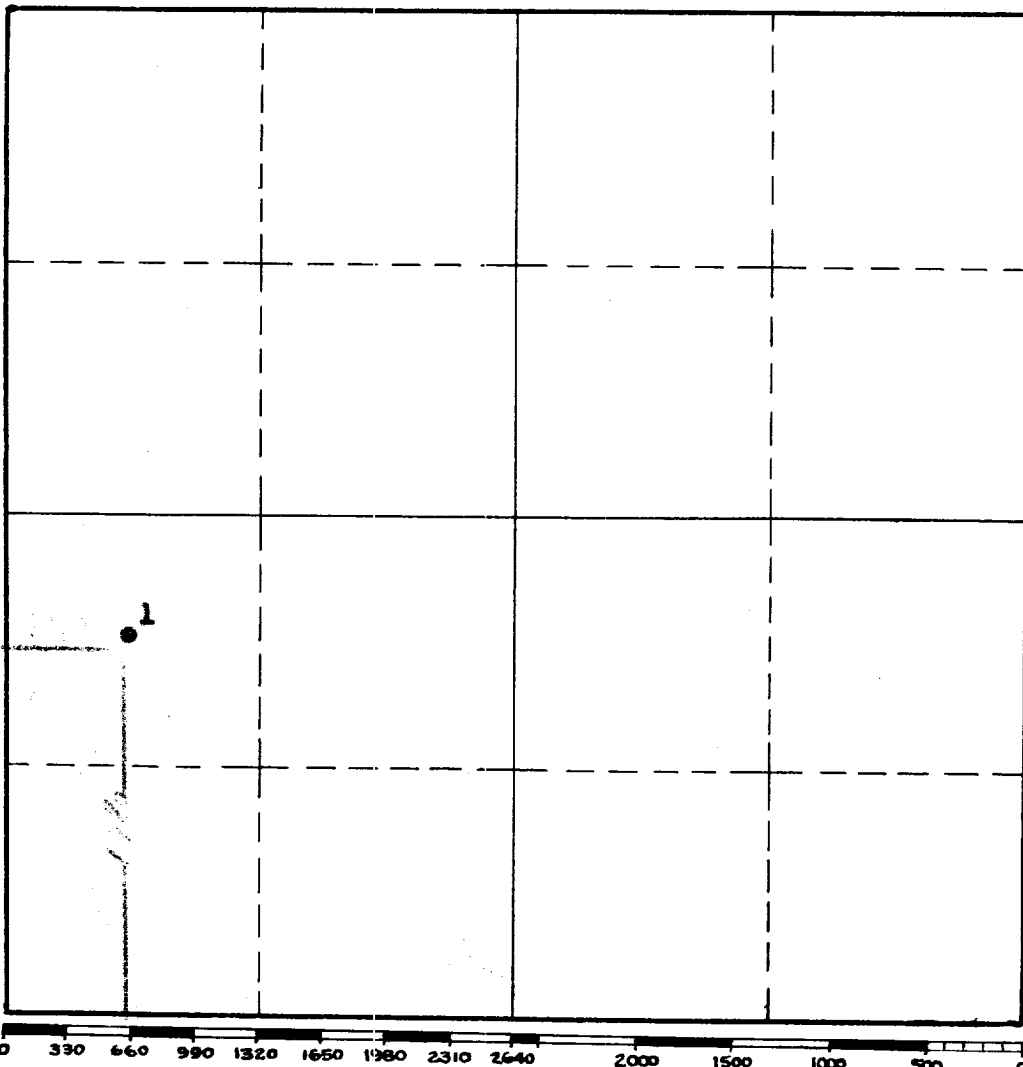
