Surface string of approximately 400 feet of 10" on line on top of salt - Cement with <del>100 sacks</del> fifty sacks.						
Oil string of approximately 5000 feet of 7" O.D. if oil is encountered - Cement with <del>100</del> 100 sacks, and circulate sufficient mud ahead of cement.						

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil and gas sand should occur at a depth of about 5000 feet.
