On June 26, 1968 we re-entered well and cleaned out to a total depth of 3967' which was 10' into a cement plug. Set Baker bridge plug at 3950'. Tested plug after bailing hole dry. Plug O.K.

On July 11, 1968 we perforated casing from 3129'-3361' with 20 holes and acidized with 3,000 gals. Well tested 35 barrels per day water cut with 5% oil.

On Aug. 30, 1968 bridge plug was set at 3165' and well was acidized with 2,000 gals. Well tested 37 barrels per day water with 2% oil.

On March 31, 1970 re-entered well, set plug of 25 sax over perf. from 3100' to 3165' and plug of 25 sax from 1900' to 1950'. Hole was filled with mud between plugs.

On April 1, 1970 bailed hole dry and tested plug. Test O.K. We then perforated casing from 1759' to 1765' with 14 holes. Acidized with 2,000 gals. mud acid. Well was tested with no show of oil or water and slight show of gas which was too small to measure.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
