Re: CG Kimes #1, Queen Gas Well Section 28-T15S-R29E Chaves County, New Mexico

Dear Mr. Porter:

We respectively request permission to temporarily produce the CG Kimes #1 Queen gas well through 8-5/8" casing without a tubing and packer. We have on order an 8-5/8" packer and sufficient tubing to run in the well. We expect to have delivery within two months times. A diagrammatic sketch of the well is attached. We have recently run a GR-CCL log in the well and believe the casing TD to be 1731 feet, with the Queen sand producing open hole.

The gas to be produced is sweet Queen gas, an analysis of which is enclosed. The gas is dry and goes directly into the pipeline without separation.

We are requesting this exception to Rule 107d because (1) gas production will be delayed and therefore economic waste will occur as long as the well is shut-in, and (2) production of the well without a packer will not result in waste of the gas.
