B.F. Brawley, being first duly sworn according to law, upon his oath deposes and says:

1. That he is District Engineer of Sunray DX Oil Company  
(Title) (Operator)  
whose address is Box 128, Hobbs, New Mexico
2. That Sunray DX Oil Company is the operator of a well drilled on land be-  
(Operator)  
longing to Penasco River Ranch Company, whose address is Box 1150  
(Landowner)  
Roswell, New Mexico, said well being drilled to test for hydrocarbons and/or  
carbon dioxide gas and described as the N.M. State "AV" No. 1, being located 660  
feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 22,  
Township 17 South, Range 18 East, Chaves County, New Mexico.
3. That said well was drilled to a total depth of 5913 feet, and that cas-  
ing has been set and cemented as follows:  
13 3/8" @ 119' cmt w/159 sx. Cmt. circulated to surface.  
8 5/8" @ 1190' cmt w/1400 sx. Cmt. circulated to surface.
4. That operator and landowner have made an agreement whereby operator  
/// (is not) to back fill pits, level location, and clear it of all junk. The agreement  
further provides that operator is to plug said well back to a plugged-back total depth of  
1125 feet and transfer well to landowner for his use as a water-well. Operator will  
leave casing in the well as follows:  
13 3/8" @ 119'  
8 5/8" @ 1190'
5. That when operator has complied with the provisions of Paragraph 4 above  
he will so notify the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico on Com-  
mission Form C-103, together with a signed statement from the landowner that the  
provisions of Paragraph 4 above have been complied with to his satisfaction.
