DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 3:00 p.m. (MST), June 28, 1963.
Ran 418' of 13-3/8" (48#, H-40) casing and cemented to 422' with 150 sacks cement plus 45 gal. Did not circulate. Dumped two 100 lb. sacks cotton seed hulls down annulus. Cement is to surface with approximately 85 sacks regular neat plus 45 gal. Plugged down - 3:00 p.m. (MST), July 3, 1963.
After WOC five days, tested with 900 psi for 30 minutes - no pressure drop.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
