Dear Sir,

The captioned oil well has a gas-oil ratio greater than 30,000-1 and is to be re-classified as a gas well in this field. According to Rule 3 of Case 4352, Order # R-3981-A, the Director of the Commission may grant an exception to the requirements of Rule 2 (a) when a non-standard unit lies wholly within a governmental quarter section and contains less acreage than a standard 160 acre unit.

We respectfully request: 1) An exception to Rule 2 (a) for the #8 Spurck-State which is situated on a 120 acre non-standard unit
2) A gas allowable for this well.

Dalport owns the oil and gas lease covering this unit. Enclosed are two copies of C-102 showing the unit.
