Gentlemen:

The subject well was drilled in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 2, T-15-S, R-29-E and located 660' FNL and 660' FEL of the Section. The well was drilled to 2001' and completed in the Queen formation in the interval from 1890' to 1896'. It was potentialed November 21, 1970 for 714,000 cubic feet of gas per day on a 24 hour test, 1" choke and 275# flowing tubing pressure. The well has been shutin since that date.

I now own the well and am ready to produce it. I have a farmout on the N/2NE/4, SW/4 NE/4 by assignment under State Lease K-6647 and own and control the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 2 under State Lease LG 1119.

Since this well will probably not produce enough gas to satisfy one-half of a proration unit, it is requested that an exception be granted to Rule 2, Order R3981-A as amended by R4434, Rule 3 for a non-standard proration unit covering the NE/4 of Section 2, T-15-S, R-29-E.
