SUPPLEMENT TO THE OIL CORPORATION SCHEDULE

DATE: 10/1/1940
PURPOSE: To provide information regarding the operations of the Oil Corporation of the United States, and to show the results of its operations for the year ended December 31, 1939.

The Oil Corporation of the United States was organized on January 1, 1939, for the purpose of acquiring, developing, producing, refining, and distributing oil and other petroleum products. The Corporation has since that time acquired and developed oil and gas properties in various parts of the United States, and has produced and refined oil and gas products. The Corporation has also distributed these products to its customers.
