The subject well is SI currently waiting on a waterflood study being performed by Yates Petroleum. My last contact with Yates indicated they are still studying the flood and wish to include the Sulimar #1 & #2 in the flood unit. Current oil pricing of less than \$15.00 per BO will prevent the flood from being activated in the short term, but we are optimistic about activating the flood with Yates Petroleum as Operator in the future after oil prices have escalated. Read & Stevens requests the subject well remain shut-in until the study is completed and oil prices improve to support an economic flood thereby conserving resources and protecting correlative rights.
