Dear Mr. Wilson:

In response to your questions concerning an assignment of allowable for the Corinne Grace State Well No. 3 located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 1, Township 15 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Chaves County, I will outline certain things the Commission Rules require be done.

First, pursuant to Rule 11 of the Special Pool Rules for the Double L-Queen Associated Gas Pool, copies of Forms C-104 and C-105 must be filed which contain completion data. Copies of these forms are enclosed.

An exception to these Special Pool Rules must be obtained dedicating a non-standard proration unit to the well. This can be done in an administrative proceeding without hearing. You should request approval of the non-standard unit in a letter to the Secretary-Director of the Commission which contains those things set out in Oil Conservation Commission Rule 104 D 2. It should be emphasized that all offset operators must either sign waivers or proof of their notification of your seeking a non-standard unit must be submitted.
