Gentlemen:

Pursuant to our telephone conversation in connection with UV Industries, Inc.'s Application to drill the subject well, the following information is furnished:

- A. Blowout Preventer Program
  - 1. The drilling rig will be equipped with a 10" 900, 3,000 psi working pressure, Shaffer Type "SS" blowout preventer with double rams (one blind and one for drill pipe).
  - 2. The blowout preventer will be actuated by a Payne hydraulic closing unit.
  - 3. After setting 8 5/8" casing, the casing and blowout preventer will be tested to 1,000 psi for 30 minutes.
  - 4. The blowout preventer will be operated daily.

Cactus Drilling Company rig No. 64 will drill the well and Cactus is mailing directly to you a schematic diagram of the blowout preventer system to be used.

B. Gas Dedication

The acreage upon which the subject well will be drilled is presently dedicated to a gas purchaser.

C. Operator of Long Canyon Unit

UV Industries, Inc. has been designated in the Long Canyon Unit as the operator of such unit.
