Please review the enclosed C-103, C-104, C-105 forms regarding the above described well. An attempt was made to run a conventional 4-point back pressure test; however, no three points could be aligned as required by the "Manual for Back-Pressure Testing of Natural Gas Wells". The shut in tubing pressure after 72 hrs was 2100#. A 4 point test was attempted and after 1 hour, the tubing pressure had dropped to 290#. This test was attempted on a 6/64 chk. The 290# was the pressure of the pipeline in which the well was connected. The well was then left producing into the pipeline for the next 24 hours and had a gas volume of 206 mcf over this period with no condensate production. This test was conducted from 6-10-89 thru 6-11-89. Production has been steady from 195-206 mcf/d for the next 4 days. Please accept this letter as an explanation for the lack of submittal of form C-122 & worksheet.
