APPLICATION OF McCLELLAN OIL CORPORATION
FOR AN UNORTHODOX OIL WELL LOCATION,
CHAVES COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on January 3, 1980, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this 16th day of January, 1980, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, McClellan Oil Corporation, seeks approval of an unorthodox oil well location for its Marlisue State Well No. 6 to be drilled at a point 1155 feet from the North line and 2475 feet from the West line of Section 24, Township 14 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, to test the Queen formation, Double "L"-Queen Associated Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the NE/4 NW/4 of said Section 24 is to be dedicated to the well.
- (4) That a well at said unorthodox location will better enable applicant to produce the oil underlying the proration unit.
- (5) That no offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox location.

- DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year herein-
above designated.
- (3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the
entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
- (2) That the NE/4 NW/4 of said Section 24 shall be dedi-
cated to the above-described well.
- (1) That an unorthodox oil well location for the Queen
Marisque State Well No. 6 to be drilled at a point 1155 feet
from the North line and 2475 feet from the West line of Section
24, Township 14 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Double "L"-Queen
Associated Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(6) That approval of the subject application will afford
the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable
share of the oil in the subject pool, will prevent the economic
loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the
augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive
number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect
correlative rights.

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
