DEPCO, Inc. No. 1 Papalotes Federal 990 FNL & 1980 FWL Section 14-T15S-R28E Chaves County, New Mexico

This plan is submitted with Form 9-331C, Application for Permit to Drill covering the above described well. The purpose of this plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the necessary surface disturbance and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operations, so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation.

- 1. EXISTING ROADS.
 - A. Exhibit A is a portion of the USGS Map of Chaves County, New Mexico, on a scale of 1" = 2000 showing the area of the proposed wellsite and the roads in the vicinity. The wellsite is located approximately 14 miles Southeast of Hagerman, New Mexico, and part of the access route to the location is indicated in red on Exhibit A.
 - (1) Proceed east on Highway 31 from Hagerman, New Mexico, for approximately 14 miles to the intersection of Highway 31 and caliche pipeline road going southeast just east of abandoned missle silo.
 - (2) Turn right on caliche road and continue southeast for approximately 4 miles to intersection with a ranch road going west.
 - (3) Turn right and go west approximately 2.9 miles to proposed location.
 - (4) At this point, the ranch road crosses the proposed drilling site and the location is staked and flagged and clearly visible.
 - B. The existing improved access road has numerous turnouts, is in good condition, and will require minimal repair. The unimproved existing access road will be widened to 12 feet in width and will be covered with six inches of compacted caliche. The road will be crowned with drainage on both sides and approximately 5 turnouts will be necessary.
- 2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD.
 - A. No new access road will be required as existing road crosses proposed location.
