Dear Mr. Townsend:

This letter is to advise you that BEC Corporation, formerly Bliss Energy Corporation, continues to be the Operator of the captioned well. BEC Corporation has not executed any change of operator form naming a successor operator, and any such form previously filed with the Oil Conservation Division of the State of New Mexico by Paul Bliss is completely unauthorized.

Paul Bliss is claiming a 51.5625% working interest in the lease by virtue of assignment from J. R. Canon, Trustee of the JRC Trust, which assignment is dated February 16, 1990 purportedly effective January 1, 1990. Please be advised that the JRC Trust interest was subject to the terms of an Operating Agreement dated January 1, 1989 covering the Gulf Federal Lease naming Bliss Energy Corporation, now BEC Corporation, as Operator. This Operating Agreement contained a preferential right to purchase provision which was not met by the JRC Trust in the purported assignment to Paul Bliss. Therefore, the assignment to Bliss is ineffective and Paul Bliss owns no interest in the Gulf Federal Lease.

Further, the working interest of the JRC Trust is delinquent in paying its share of lease operating expenses which total \$5,214.28 for expenses from January 1, 1990 through May 31, 1991. BEC Corporation is in the process of invoking the Operator's lien provided for in the Operating Agreement to collect these expenses.

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
