Dear Ms. McMahon:

Our records indicate that both of the subject wells were less than six times overproduced at the beginning of May. Applying both the April and May allowables of 49,325 and 107,966, respectively, and the April production to the March 31, 1988 well status, the wells were overproduced, respectively, only 77,988 and 53,254 MCF on May 1, 1988. Since this amounts to only 2.1 and 1.4 times overproduced, for wells 8 and 9, respectively, it is permissible to return the wells to production immediately.
