Notice of Overproduction

Dear Sir:

The subject prorated gas well is in violation of Rule 11(b) of the New Mexico General Rules for Prorated Gas Pools. The September, 1986 Proration Schedule shows this prorated gas well exceeding six times its average monthly allowable by the amount of 882,330 MCF. Your State "ET" Gas Com Well No. 1 must be shut-in and remain shut-in until the accumulated overproduction is reduced to within its allowable limits.

Effective October 1, 1986, Phillips 66 Natural Gas Company will not accept any further deliveries from the subject well until we have received notification in writing that the well has been approved to resume production. A copy of any orders approving a hardship status or approval to produce at a reduced rate is also requested. Well No. 1 is connected to Phillips 66 Natural Gas Company's gathering system serving the Lusk Plant.
