Per your letter dated February 19, 1993, informing us of Bridge's attempt to side-track the subject well and recomplete in the adjacent 40-acre proration unit to the east of the original 40-acre tract.

This matter has been set for hearing on the next available docket scheduled for April 8, 1993. As you are probably aware, General Rule 104.F(1) does not provide an administrative procedure for approving unorthodox oil well location requests for geological purposes.

Please provide adequate notice of hearing to the appropriate parties pursuant to Rule 1207.A(5).
