RE: Application of Medallion Production Company for approval to drill its U.S.A. "20" Well No. 1 at an unorthodox gas well location 990' FSL - 1100' FEL (Unit P) of Section 20, Township 15 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Chaves County, to test the Atoka and Morrow formations within a 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit comprising the S/2 of said Section 20

Dear Mr. Carr:

The proposed well and 320-acre unit is bounded to the east and north by the Buffalo Valley-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, therefore, the Medallion proposed well is subject to the "General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Buffalo Valley-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, which allows wells to be located either in the NW/4 or SE/4 of a section and is to be located no closer than 990 feet to the outer boundary of the quarter section nor closer than 330 feet to any governmental quarter-quarter section line.

Since this location is only unorthodox internally, it may qualify for administrative approval. I offer this only as a suggestion.

The application sent over on Tuesday, August 29, 1995, has been scheduled on the docket for hearing before a Division Examiner on September 21, 1995.
