Your letter and Notice of Intention To Drill, under date of August 7th, 1939, received. Also one Well Bond, on Form 39-B-1.

I am this day mailing your bond to Mr. Carl B. Livingston, Santa Fe, New Mexico, for approval, as bonds are not approved by this office.

In your Notice of Intention to Drill I notice that you propose to run three (3) to four (4) hundred feet of ten inch (10^n) second hand casing, without cementing. This we do not approve.

I would advise that you cement the surface string with ten inch easing with at least twenty (20) sacks of cement, as this is the program that the Conservation Commission is trying to work out for the Artesia Area.
