Dear Mr. Yarborough:


I find that I do not have any blank forms for making reports to the Oil Inspector and will ask you to kindly send me a supply of all forms to be used in making reports on wells drilled on State or Patented lands, that I may use same in reporting the progress of the Hoffmann No. 1 well, in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 14, T. 17 S., R. 24 E.

Will you also send me another copy of Circular No. 1, covering "General Rules and Regulations of Oil Conservation Commission." (Someone seems to have "borrowed" our office copy.)

The Hoffmann No. 1 well is drilled to a depth of about 260 feet, and judging from the formation so far, we believe it will be possible to carry 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ " casing to the top of the lime without the aid of a ten inch surface string. As a matter of economy, we would like to eliminate the proposed ten inch string, and trust this change will meet with the approval of your office.

We received letter from Mr. Carl B. Livingston, Attorney for the Oil Conservation Commission, in which he approves of the drilling bond.
