Your letter of August 21, 1939 received.

In regard to your Hoffman No. 1 well, I am still holding your Notice of Intention to Drill for the reason that your piping program you have does not conform with the rules and regulations of the Commission.

I do not have authority to change those rules.

In your letter you state that you do not intend to even run ten inch. I would advise that you set ten inch pipe and cement through the surface water, as I have written you before.

I do not have authority to OK any piping program without it being cemented.
