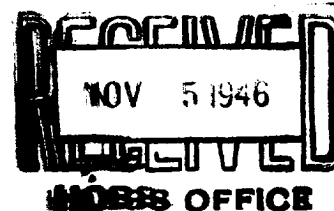

After letting set for five days, we

Drilled 5' below the pipe and put approximately 500# pressure on it for thirty minutes. Showed no indication of leak or loss of pressure, so proceeded to drill ahead.

625' of 13" pipe was set and cemented with 100 sacks of Portland Cement.
