DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well drilled to 3065' by Mesa Retailers. Humble to deepen well to 8500'. Rigged up rotary rig. Set bridge plug at 1591'. Perforated 8-5/8" casing at 1125'. Set retrievable cementer at 1116'. Cemented 8-5/8" casing with 950 sacks Lone Star cement. Approx. 20 sacks returned to surface. Job complete at 1:15 PM, 2-27-50. Tested casing and BOP with 1000# for 30 minutes at 1:15 PM, 2-28-50. Tested OK. Drilled cement retainer at 1116' and bridge plug at 1591'.
