Since the load was so long in coming back, the pumper was unaware that the well was on new production and contacted purchaser without our knowledge to move the new oil. The purchaser ran 332 Bb1s. of new oil. It was our intention to test this well for an extended period before making a potential, and it was our opinion that the tank room was adequate to handle this small amount of oil.
