

casing is deep enough to shut off all of the Artesian zone and the one plug at 2475' is below the top of the Glorietta section which probably accounts for the sulfur water.

I inspected this well on Friday, October 1, and found the fluid level at approximately 25' from surface. Also, a string of 6 5/8" casing has been run in the well and welded to a swedge nipple from the 9 5/8" surface casing with a 6" gate valve installed which was open. Also, the circulating and reserve pits were not filled and leveled.
