Dear Bill:

Mr. Russell Crawford of the Pecos Valley Artesian Conservancy District of Roswell, New Mexico, was in our office on September 27, 1954. However, I was in the field at the time he called.

Mr. Crawford states that the above mentioned well is leaking or flowing sulfur water in the winter months and has been for the past two years. He also said that he would probably contact DeKalb in regard to properly plugging this well or the Conservancy District might even plug it with their own equipment. I have reviewed our file on this well and would like for you to have a look at your Santa Fe file and let me know what our position is in regard to this matter. You will note on Form C-103, Report of Plugging, that the proposed plan of plugging was obtained orally, pending approval of the land Commissioner, when it should have been the approval of the Ground Water Supervisor or Conservancy District since the well was drilled on patented land and in the Roswell Artesian Water Basin. The geological formation tops from the scout ticket are as follows: Gloristta 2130°, Drinkard 3511°, Abo 4224°, and there was no San Andres top reported. I don't believe that 991° of 9 5/8" surface
