Total Depth 1083'

Drilled plug at 2:00 P. M. April 11, 1953. Tested Casing. Circulated behind casing with 500# pump pressure. Set Baker cement retainer at 1050'. Squeezed with 100 sacks cement plus 2% Calcium Chloride. Plug down at 7:00 P. M. Cement went in place at 800 # pressure, final pumping pressure 1600#. W. O. C. 12 hours. Drilled retainer and cement to bottom of hole. Tested with 1,000# pressure for one hour, no loss in pressured. Drilling ahead.
