DETAILS OF WORK

Well drilled to 462 feet, no shows of oil or gas. Well plugged and abandoned. Hole filled with mud to 300 feet from bottom, and set cement plug with ten sacks of cement. Pulled 2 1/8 foot of 8 5/8" casing and casing shoe. Filled hole with mud to surface. Set marker using four sacks of cement. Levelled up pit and cleaned up location. Plugging completed and marker set on June 27, 1959.
