Dear Mr. Latch:

As you will recall, we talked about the subject gas well earlier this month. At that time, I told you that, since the well was located too close to the quarter section line for a standard gas well location, the non standard location would have to be approved by the commission. When I discussed this matter with our Santa Fe office, they told me that to obtain approval for the non standard location you would have to apply for the same and have a hearing before the Commission in Santa Fe. However, we also discussed the possibility of making a change in Commission rules to allow administrative approval of such non standard locations without the need for a hearing. Therefore, if you are in a great hurry for approval of the non standard location, you should apply now for a hearing. Otherwise, I feel that the rules change will probably be made and no hearing will be required.

I regret that so much time has elapsed since we discussed this matter but I have been out of the office until now.
