Enclosed is the original and four (4) copies of OCC Form C-104 providing for a change of ownership for the subject well.

I have had two discussions with Mr. R. D. Collier concerning the maintenance of a bond for the Brainard Well. Mr. Collier advised that his bond covered this well, and as you may know, there is a bond maintained on this same well by C & H Oils. Since Mr. Collier's bond covers several wells, and he intends to maintain his bond, he has agreed to accept ownership of the well as provided in the enclosed OCC Form C-104.
