DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

We set 7" O.D. Casing at 354', cementing with 25 sacks cement, work was done by the Denton Oil Well Cementing Co. After allowing same to set 75 hours we drilled and tested for water shut-off which we found to be satisfactory. We then acidized with 1,000 gallons of acid from 358' to 360', which increased the production from 2 barrels a day to 8 barrels per day. The Artesia Chemical Company done this work.
