Gentlemen:

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Form C-115 for the month of March, 1957 on Owen Haynes Harbold Well No. 12-E in Section 35, T-17-S, R-27-E, Red Lake Pool, indicates that 148.51 barrels of oil was produced and sold. Further, the same form indicates that the well had no allowable for the month of March. The above information was certified to be true by Erma G. Williams.

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Form C-112 for the month of March, 1957 certified to be true by W. B. Young for Malco Refineries, Inc. indicates that for the Owen Haynes Harbold Well No. 12 149 barrels of oil was purchased.

Records on file in this office indicate that this well did not have an allowable for the month of March. Therefore the 149 barrels of oil produced from this lease during March is illegal oil and subject to the penalty provisions as outlined in Section 65-3-27 which appears on page 79 of the Rules and Regulations.

Oil may be produced and purchased only after it has been authorized by the Oil Proration Schedule of supplement thereof.

You are hereby directed to cease production and transportation of oil from the above named well immediately. Further, a written explanation of this violation as to the production and transportation of this illegal oil is requested at your earliest convenience.
